Prerequisite Courses and Admission Procedures

Lynchburg College course equivalent

The underlined courses are the courses at Lynchburg College that can be used to satisfy the Physical Therapy pre-requisites. This is only a guide. Students are encouraged to speak directly with the PT program director.

Pre-requisite courses

Lynchburg College Equivalent

● Sciences- 31 sem. hrs

- 4 sem. hrs Biology with lab* BIOL 111, 112
- 8 sem. hrs Chemistry with lab* CHEM 103/105, 104/106, 127,251/252, 252/254
- 8 sem. hrs Physics with lab (non-calculus based) PHYS 141, 142, 161, 162
- 4 sem. hrs Human Anatomy with lab ^ BIOL 214/L
- 4 sem. hrs Human Physiology with lab^ BIOL 215/L

BIOL 222 and 223 taken together satisfy the Anatomy and Physiology requirements

- 3 sem. hrs Advanced Biology (Histology, Cell Biology, Micro Biology, are examples but many courses may satisfy)

BIOL 220, 323,356,360, 424, BIOM 354

● Psychology- 6 sem. Hrs PSYC 103/105, 104/106, 212, 215,241, 261, 344

● Writing Intensive courses 9 sem. Hrs (Freshman composition and writing intensive courses accepted)

ENGL 111, 112, any research course, any LCSR course

● Math- 6 sem. hrs

- pre-calculus or above MATH 102, 103, 104, 211
- 3 sem. hrs Statistics MATH 222, PSYC 274, SOCI 370, BUAD 241

Any courses/coursework older than 7 years will be reviewed for determination as meeting the pre-requisite approval by the DPT admissions committee. This is done to ensure that students with old courses still have the knowledge to be successful in the DPT program.

* = These courses should be equivalent to courses required in the science majors.

^ = Academic institutions offering Human Anatomy/Physiology combination courses will suffice if both courses of sequence are completed; example: 4 hrs. Human A & P I and 4 hrs. Human A & P II).
