*Our Daily Itinerary (subject to change):*

### DAY 1: DEPART USA

Depart on our overnight transatlantic flight to London, United Kingdom. Meals and snacks are served on board.

### DAY 2: ARRIVE LONDON

Upon arrival in London, we are greeted by our World Cultural Tours representative and escorted to our private motor coach for transfer to our hotel. We enjoy a guided orientation tour of the city, highlighting Big Ben and the Houses of Parliament, Westminster Abbey, Piccadilly Circus and Leicester Square. Our tour includes the opportunity to observe the changing of the guard at Buckingham Palace (*subject to event taking place*) as well as a flight on the London Eye. We gather for a medieval Welcome Banquet this evening.

### DAY 3: LONDON

Following breakfast this morning, we use our travelcards and enjoy a guided sightseeing tour of the city, including a visit to the infamous Tower of London, which has been an important part of Britain's history for nearly 1,000 years. This evening, we attend a performance at a local theatre in London.

### DAY 4: LONDON

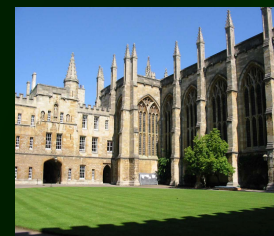

## DAY 5: LONDON

After breakfast this morning, we continue our sightseeing in London with a visit to Clink Prison Museum, built upon the original site of Clink Prison. The prison dates back to 1144, making it one of England's oldest prisons. We have the afternoon free for self-arranged activities. This evening, we enjoy a "Jack the Ripper Tour," delving into the crooked, cobbled alleyways of Whitechapel to follow the infamous trail of terror.

## DAY 7: LONDON

After breakfast this morning, we visit Sherlock Holmes Museum, where Sherlock Holmes and Doctor John H. Watson lived between 1881-1904, according to stories written by Sir Arthur Conan Doyle. This afternoon, we visit the Royal Courts of Justice, opened by Queen Victoria in 1882 and also what become the permanent home of the Supreme Court. Dinner is under our own arrangements this evening.

## DAY 8: LONDON - EDINBURGH

Following breakfast this morning, we depart London and transfer to Edinburgh, known as the *Athens of the North*. Upon arrival, we check into our hotel and gather for our Welcome Dinner at a local restaurant this evening.

## DAY 9: EDINBURGH

This morning after breakfast, we enjoy a full day of guided sightseeing in Kincardine and Edinburgh. Our first visit is to the Scottish Police College, which is a central police training establishment serving all eight police forces in Scotland, comprising some 14,500 officers. This afternoon, we return to Edinburgh and visit Edinburgh Castle, housing over one thousand years of history, atop the famous Edinburgh rock. Dinner is self-arranged this evening.

## DAY 10: EDINBURGH

This morning after breakfast, we visit Her Majesty's Prison Edinburgh, colloquially known as Saughton Prison. Classed as a local or community prison, it receives prisoners from the courts in Edinburgh. We have the balance of the day at leisure for independent sightseeing, shopping and relaxing.
