W	May 18	Fly to Europe
TH	May 19	Arrive Entebbe – Overnight at Pope Paul Guest House
F	May 20	Breakfast followed by drive to Gulu. Upon arrival we will have an orientation. Dinner and overnight at Churchill Lodge
S	May 21	Devotion with staff at farm. Sports/Construction
Su	May 22	Worship with Gulu community at New Foundations Church, lunch and afternoon of Sports and community work. Dinner and overnight at Churchill.
M	May 23	Devotion with staff at farm. Divide into Public Health Education, Construction and Outreach teams. Dinner and overnight at Churchill.
T	May 24	Same as May 23
W	May 25	Morning devotion with staff. Dedication of Anna’s well and community celebration that will include sports, dancing etc. Dinner and overnight at Churchill.
Th	May 26	Breakfast and time with staff in Gulu. Afternoon drive to Kampala followed by dinner and overnight at pope Paul’s
F	May 27	Breakfast and drive to Entebbe. Mid morning flight to Nairobi. Orientation followed by shopping and relax. Overnight at Grace House
S	May 28	Work with staff at SOM School in the morning. Afternoon sports and visit to homes. Dinner and overnight at Grace House.
Su	May 29	Breakfast followed by drive to Wilson airport. Flight to Masai Mara Wildlife Reserve. Short drive from airstrip to the Safari Lodging. After lunch a Game Drive!
M	May 30	Early morning wake-up. Coffee or Tea followed by Game Drive #2 that includes a bush breakfast. Shower, pack, lunch at the Lodge. followed by an afternoon flight to Nairobi. Freshen up at Grace House and drive to International Airport for flight to Amsterdam!

Budget

What this includes – Cost includes everything but your vaccinations, passport, souvenirs.

What should I bring? You will provided with a packing list but you must limit personal items to one carry on and one check in (wt. limit of 40lbs.).

How much money should I take? You will only need personal money for food in the airports going and coming and souvenirs. WE recommend no more that \$250.00. Be certain bills are in currency printed 2005 or newer. Credit cards work very well in airports!

What if the political situation or climate becomes unsettled? SOI has a full time staff on the ground in Uganda and Kenya as well as contacts within the US Embassy. If there is any indication of trouble or danger we will cancel the trip. If that were to occur you would get back all funds except for a penalty that the airlines might impose (usually between \$100-\$350).

Payment timeline

Due to the limited number of available flights the airline will require that we reserve the seats on Tuesday, Feb. 15. Full Payment will be within the next 21 days.

Therefore you must have turn in no less than \$1733 on or before March 7, 2011.

Balance (\$1550) is due on or before April 20, 2011.
