December 27, 2009

Departure on an international flight to India.

December 28, 2009

Late night arrival in Chennai where you are met by a CSA On-site Coordinator. Transfer to your hotel.

City tour of Chennai with a local guide.

December 30, 2009

December 31, 2009

January 1, 2010

Private coach transfer to **Mamallapuram**. Afternoon city tour with a local guide.

January 5, 2010

Private coach transfer to **Agra** visiting **Sikandra** en-route. Afternoon visit to **Agra Fort**.

Early morning visit of the **Taj Mahal** with a local guide. Continue to Delhi for a special **Farewell Dinner** and then continue to the airport for your return flight to the USA (departure early morning of January 11).
