Spend three and half weeks immersed in the French-speaking culture and European charm of Quebec City, Canada. While abroad, you will live with host families and enroll in intensive language courses at Laval University, the oldest French-speaking university in North America.

Morning classes in language acquisition will focus on listening comprehension and oral expression with heavy use of the communicative method. Instruction will also include some writing, and class work will stem from real life situations and every day topics. Laval University's instructors are experts in teaching French as a foreign language.

After class, students will have further instruction with Dr. Mayer to review the morning session as well as cultural activities that will engage students in language practice. Students will also have the opportunity to take advantage of outdoor recreation with hiking and kayaking excursions, in addition to visiting historical sites in beautiful Quebec City.

To enhance the cultural experience and maximize language practice, participants will stay with host families carefully selected by the Laval University's International Office. Each host family will provide students with a single room and breakfast and dinner daily. Students will be responsible for buying their lunches. Taking part in a home-stay is a wonderful experience and offers students an unparalleled opportunity for language practice, cultural exchange, and making lifelong friends.
