The Governor's Challenge is an online and live competition open to teams of high school students across the Commonwealth. There is no charge to compete.

Participating schools can enter teams in three divisions:

- **Personal Finance**
(for students enrolled in a course that includes some personal finance content)
- **Economics—David Ricardo Division**
(for students enrolled in a one-semester general economics course or a course that includes some economics-related content)
- **Economics—Adam Smith Division**
(for students enrolled in an IB, AP, honors, college-level or two-semester economics course)



Important Dates

Online Challenge: March 7 — April 4

Division teams of up to four students compete within their state region—teams participate in one of eight state regions. Each team member is given a 30-question online exam at their school. Division teams earning the highest combined score in their region will receive an award and advance to the live competition.

Live Challenge: April 20

Twelve teams from each division, including all regional winners, will be invited to compete in Richmond.

Team registration begins January 1, 2012

Any student team sponsored and registered by a school-sanctioned teacher may participate in up to two divisions.
