How does SMG work?

Student teams in grades 4-12 receive a virtual \$100,000 to invest in stocks, bonds, and mutual funds during a session. Teachers must pre-register their teams online at www.vcee.org or www.stockmarketgame.org. Teams enter trades on the Internet using the ticker symbol of each company or fund and watch their portfolio value change as the stock market does.

The Stock Market Game™ program is offered to elementary, middle, and high school students! Lesson plans are available to weave into your existing curricula.

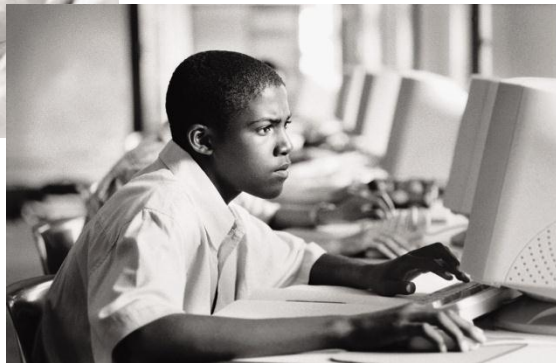

SMG teaches how the U.S. economic system works, while reinforcing basic concepts in math, business, economics, language arts, social studies, personal finance, and more.



Through participation in The Stock Market Game™, students will be able to:

- ▶ Develop and apply math skills, including: basic computations with whole numbers, fractions and decimals; percentages to analyze financial situations; create and interpret circle and line graphs
- ▶ Explain the process of buying and selling a stock
- ▶ Locate, research, and summarize information about the economy in the newspaper
- ▶ Understand, develop and apply team skills
- ▶ Think critically while integrating current events to concepts learned in social studies, math, and language arts.
