Overview

Following check-in, camp will run from 9 A.M. until 6 p.m. In the morning we will conduct a pro style workout along with batting practice and hitting instruction. When the workout is completed we will then go into our afternoon portion of showcase games. This is an instructional camp so all players will be taught the basic fundamentals that we feel are necessary to be successful in college.



Program and Coaching

Information

Since Percy Abell became head coach at Lynchburg College in 1998, he has turned the baseball program into a winning one. With 11 years under his belt, Coach Abell has produced 8 straight winning seasons of 20+ wins, including finishing the regular season first in the conference in 2008.

In 2004, the Lynchburg baseball team was statistical champion in three offensive categories, including batting average (.380), scoring (11.2 runs/game), and slugging percentage (.575), as well as, being ranked as high as 16th in the nation. In 2008, the Hornets set the school record for wins in a season at 32 and finished the season ranked 13th in the nation. The 2008 team was also the first team since 1983 to advance to the NCAA Regional Tournament.
