

BEARD CENTER ON AGING AND THE LIFE COURSE 2010 PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST: "A PORTRAIT OF AGING"

OBJECTIVE: To raise awareness of aging while encouraging interaction between students, faculty, and staff with the aging population.

JUDGING: Winning photographs will be selected by a committee comprised of Lynchburg College faculty and staff. Photographs will be judged based on the following criteria:

- Originality & Creativity
- Relativeness to the aging theme
- Quality

Judging will take place in two rounds with photographs judged anonymously each time. During the first round, students, faculty and staff will have an opportunity to vote on the photos they feel best meet the aforementioned criteria. During the second round a panel of judges comprised of Lynchburg faculty and staff will select a first and second place winner, incorporating student, faculty and staff input and the criteria listed above.

RULES:

- All current part-time and full-time Lynchburg College undergraduate and graduate students, faculty and staff are eligible to enter this contest. Each entrant can enter one original photograph.
- All entries must be complete when turned in. A complete entry includes a photo and a completed entry form with signature releases.
- All photographs must be your original work.
- All photos must at least 8x10 in size and be printed on photo paper. Both color and black and white photos are acceptable. Inkjet printed photographs, slides, and e-mailed photographs WILL NOT be accepted.
- All entries must be turned in to the Lynchburg College Beard Center (located Hopwood Hall 3rd floor, Room 304 - elevator side) by **5 P.M. on Monday, February 1st, 2010.**

CONTEST AWARDS: For each division, including the student division and the faculty/staff division, a first and second place winner will be determined and prizes awarded as follows:

1st Place: \$100 cash
2nd Place: \$75 cash

ANNOUNCEMENT OF WINNERS:

Winners will be announced and their work will be displayed outside of the Burton Dining Room on February 23rd, 2010 between 11 AM and 1 PM.
