COLLECTIONS

The Daura Museum collection spans the 20th and 21st centuries with American and European paintings, works on paper, sculpture and photography; outsider folk art; important works by Catalan-American modernist Pierre Daura (1896-1976), and paintings by Lynchburg artists Queena Stovall (1887-1980), Georgia Morgan (1869-1951), and Raphael Alphonso Umaña Mendez (1908-1994). The world cultures collection features arts from Africa, Asia, and Oceania.
