University of Lynchburg DPT Program will offer a minimum of 15 guaranteed positions to qualified University of Lynchburg students. Effective on July 1, 2014 (revised 2019) students seeking admission through the articulation agreement are required to:

1. Indicate intent to apply by sending an email to the DPT Program's Admissions Coordinator by **October 15** of the year prior to the start date of the next cohort.
2. Submit a completed application through the Physical Therapy Centralized Application System (PTCAS) at www.PTCAS.org by **December 15** of the same year.

Example: A student wishing to join the cohort starting in June of 2019 must indicate their intent by October 15, 2018, and must complete and formally submit an application through PTCAS by December 15, 2018.
