Admission to the Nursing Major

1. Application and Deadline

- a. Second Degree Students will enter Lynchburg College in May of each year. The application must be completed and submitted by March 1. Students can either apply through LC or through NursingCAS
- b. Admitted students are required to have a criminal background check per the Virginia Board of Nursing Regulation 18 VAC 90-20-100. Detailed information regarding the criminal background check will be provided.

2. Admission Requirements

- a. Completion of CHEM 127 (general chemistry), MATH 222 (statistics), HP 270 (nutrition), PSYC 241 (developmental psychology), BIO 222 (Anatomy & Physiology I), BIO 223 (Anatomy & Physiology II) with a minimum grade of "C"
- b. Minimum cumulative QPA of 3.0
- c. Minimum QPA of 3.0 in completed pre-requisite courses.
- d. We do not require the TEAS test for second degree students.

3. Admission Decisions

- a. Once all admission requirements are deemed as fulfilled, priority will be determined by the following order of ranking:
 - i. QPA in completed pre-requisite courses
 - ii. Overall QPA
- b. Students will be notified of admission decisions within a month of completing the application.

4. Cost

- a. \$645 per credit hour, roughly \$6,450 Summer, \$14,190 year 1, and \$12,900 year 2
- b. \$450 ATI fee
- c. \$173 Lab Fee
- d. \$95 Technology fee

Students must meet Health, CPR, Criminal Background Check, and Drug Screening Requirements.*

Remaining in the Nursing Major

To continue to progress in the nursing major, students must maintain a B- or better in all nursing courses. If the student is not successful in obtaining the required grade, he or she may repeat the course once, if space is available. If a nursing major fails to earn a grade of B- on any two required nursing courses, the student must withdraw from the nursing major. If a student feels that he/she has not completed a nursing course with a B- or better due to extenuating circumstance, he or she may file a written appeal documenting these circumstances to the nursing program director.

* ***Students must comply with health, CPR, criminal history records check, and drug screening requirements to be admitted to clinical agencies for nursing experiences. Refer to your Nursing Student Handbook, which you will receive in your sophomore year, and any subsequent addendums for more information.***
