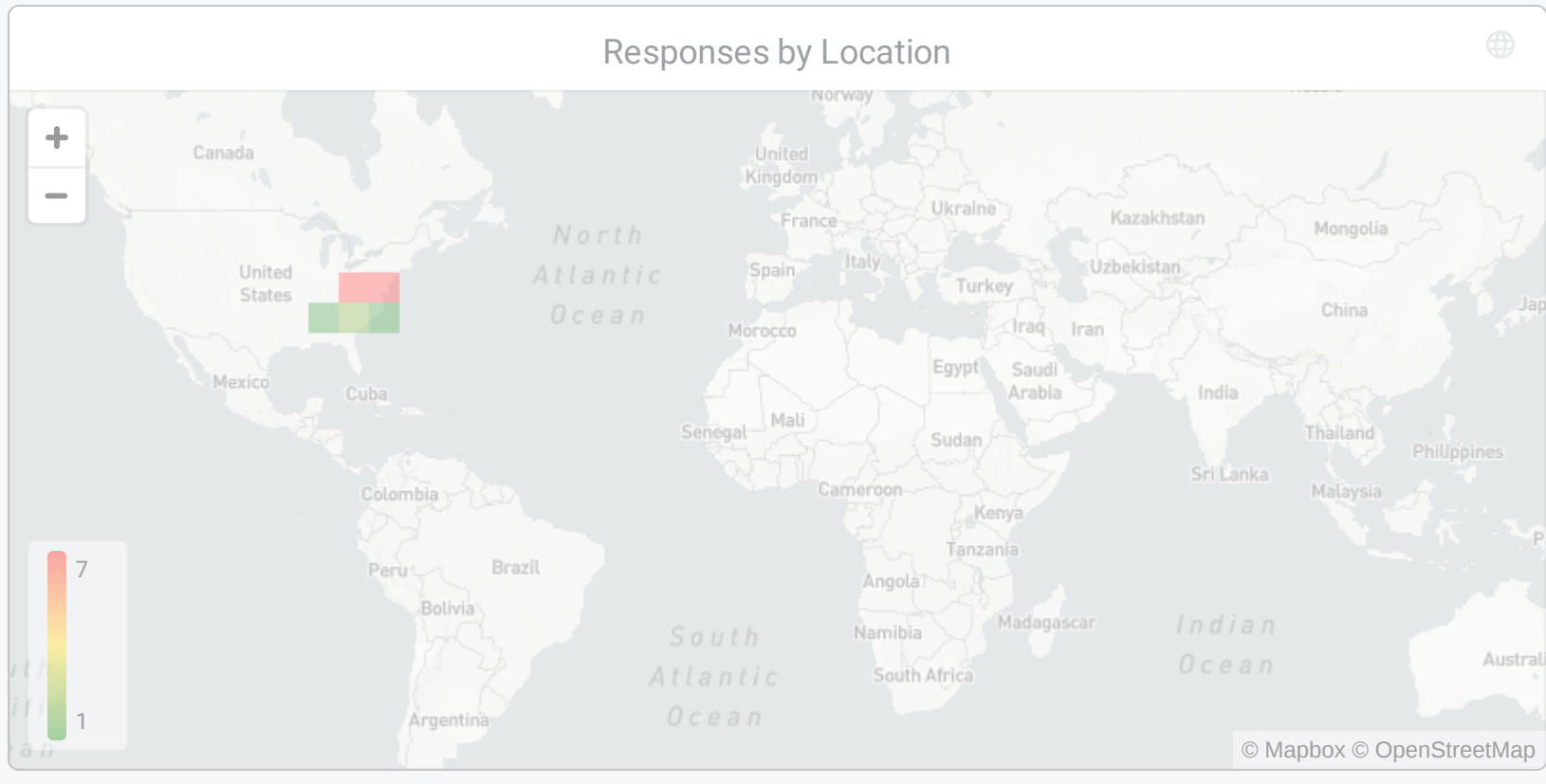
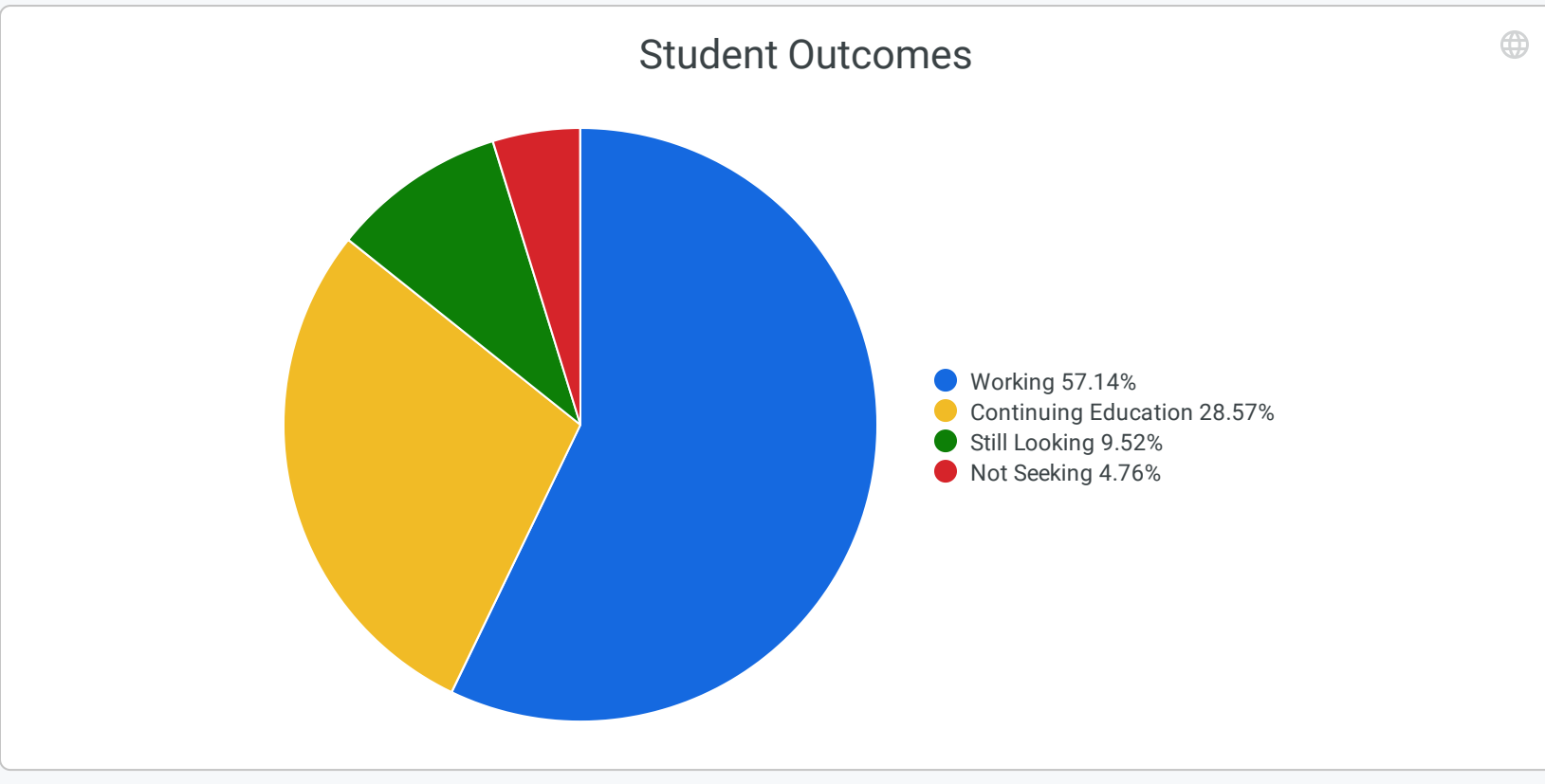


College of Business Overview

NACE's First Destination Survey (administered through the Handshake platform and managed by the Career and Professionalism Center) replaced the Outcomes Survey on career outcomes for the University of Lynchburg's graduates in May 2021. NACE's First-Destination Survey collects first career steps and graduate school admissions data from our new graduates within six months of graduation. This overview provides information about outcomes for College of Business Class of 2021 graduates within six months of graduation.

A high percentage of College of Business graduates were employed or enrolled in continuing education within six months of graduation, according to University of Lynchburg's First Destination Survey. Based on survey responses, almost 67% of the College of Business Class of 2021 graduates was working or still looking for employment within six months of graduation. This compared to 66.7% overall employment rate for private, non-for-profit institutions (NACE, 2021).

College of Business graduates began their careers mostly in Virginia, Maryland, and North Carolina. The median starting annual salary was at \$63,500 for the College of Business Class of 2021 graduates.
