

Laval - French Language Immersion
Program Update – 01Dec18

Tentative Program Fee:

4 students	\$3,275
6 students	\$3,160
8 students	\$3,105
10 students	\$2,795

*This rate does not include tuition. With the Experiential Learning Grant, tuition will be an additional \$1620 for 6 credit hours. Inclusions are listed below. In addition, students will have international medical/emergency insurance.

Program Dates:

- Session 1: May 11 - June 15, 2019

Transcripts: Students enrolled in the French immersion program receive an official transcript from Laval University - sent to University of Lynchburg at no extra cost to the student

Credits: Students take a placement test and enroll in the appropriate French language level course for the equivalent of 6 credits. Course descriptions and respective syllabi would be reviewed by the student's academic advisor and a Request for Permission for Out of Residence Study form would be completed and submitted to the Registrar to process the transfer credits upon successful completion of the course.

Academic Support:

- Students are able to set up meetings with the professor as necessary
- Animation Room (similar to UL's language learning lab/tutoring center) is open weekdays 8:30am - 4:30pm where tutors are available to assist at no extra cost

Housing:

- Students will live in on-campus residence facilities with students from all over the world
- Rooms include refrigerator and shared bathrooms
- Access to fully equipped kitchens
- Shared breakfast and dinners in French with Laval students
- Activities offered in residence halls
- Close to the grocery store and restaurants

Transportation:

- Laval University offers a free shuttle service from the airport in Quebec City to campus on May 11 and 12 from 12:30-8pm.
- Students are responsible for covering their own transportation costs for the duration of the program once they arrive in Quebec City
- Students staying in dorms will be able to walk to campus.
- Airfare will be included in the program from the U.S. to Canada.

Meals:

- Breakfast and dinner are included during the week. Students are responsible for lunches and weekend meals.
- Dorms offer a shared kitchen space where students are able to prepare their own meals if they choose

Excursions:

- Activities offered two times a week. Some are free, some require an additional fee. Students will sign up directly with Laval and are responsible for any additional fees.
